The Journey to Jesus

Non-Seeker

- 1. Trusting a Christian > focus on building a trusting relationship
- 2. Becoming Curious > focus on piquing curiosity via spiritual conversations
- 3. Opening to Change > focus on modeling the wisdom of following Christ

Seeker

- 4. Seeking Answers > focus on helping them resolve their questions
- 5. Receiving Jesus > focus on helping them ask for Jesus' leadership and forgiveness

My unsaved friend and their next needed step to salvation:

To be a Great Evangelist:

- 1. Be Wise and Loving.
- 2. Know your Audience.
- 3. Bring up Spirituality.

It's **not** the topic, it's **how** we approach it.

Genuine Curiosity > Critiques

Active Listening > Rebuttals

Spiritual Observations > Challenges

How to have a Spiritual Conversation with a non-believer:

- 1. Bring up a **neutral** topic. ex. Have you heard about the JWST? It's designed to look for life on other planets.
- 2. <u>Introduce a **spiritual** element</u>. ex. If the JWST finds life on another planet, how might that influence people's understanding of God?
- 3. Validate their feedback. ex. Fascinating! I could totally see that happening.
- 4. Contribute a Christian perspective. ex. As a Christian, my understanding is...
